- 1. A cover letter describing your qualifications for the scholarship.
- 2. Contact information (phone number is critical)
- 3. Proof of enrollment to a post secondary institution
- 4. Your current high school transcript
- 5. A letter of reference

Candidates will be shortlisted and interviewed. The interview will consist of answering these questions:

- 1. What do you do outside of school that exemplifies leadership qualities and how have these roles allowed you to help others accomplish a shared goal.
- 2. What else have you done in your school and community to make it a better place?
- 3. Describe how you have positively influenced your peers or members of your community through your leadership roles.
- 4. Where do you see yourself in 10 years?

The successful candidate will be chosen based on the interview and documentation provided to the interview committee. The contributors of the scholarship fund will choose the members of the interview committee.
